

Programs for foreign youth and residents

This is a Japanese language support program for foreign-rooted youth and sei-katsu-sha aged 15 and over who wish to learn Japanese for living and working in Japan.

Students learn not only daily conversation necessary for daily life, but also basic Japanese reading and writing such as hiragana, katakana, and beginner-level kanji.

In addition, students can take conversation classes to obtain information necessary for daily life and support classes for working (Japanese for use in the workplace, how to write resumes and take interviews, individual counseling, etc.).

*All classes are online.

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*You may need to purchase course materials depending on the class.

*If you do not have a device to take online classes, please consult with us.

(Due to the small number of students, we may not be able to lend you a device.)

【Class Overview】

Morning Class

(1) Elementary Japanese Level 1 (equivalent to N5) / (2) Elementary Japanese Level 2 (equivalent to N5-N4)

*This class concentrates on conversation at the beginner level of Japanese.

Monday - Friday 9:10 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. x 40 lessons (2 months)

Textbook used: 『Irodori Seikatsu no Nihongo (Starter/Elementary 1)』 (The Japan Foundation)

Afternoon Class

(3) JLPT N4 (Grammar)

*This class is for those who have finished basic Japanese language study and want to brush up on grammar.

Mondays and Wednesdays 1:10 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. x 16 lessons (2 months)

Textbook used: 『TRY ! JLPT N4 Bunpou kara nobasu Nihongo』 (ask)

(4) Kanji for daily life (equivalent to N4)

This class is for those who have finished basic Japanese language study and want to brush up on Kanji.

Tuesdays and Thursdays 1:10 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. x 16 lessons (2 months)

Textbook used: 『Kanji tamago Pre-intermediate』 (bonjinsha)

(5) Japanese for Settling in Japan (N4 to N3)

This class is designed for those who have completed basic Japanese language study and wish to acquire communication skills necessary for daily life in Japan.

Friday 1:10 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. x 12 lessons (3 months)

(6) Japanese for work (N4 to N3)

This class is for those who have completed basic Japanese language study and want to learn communication manners and Japanese conversation needed in the workplace, as well as how to write resumes and interview for job hunting.

Friday 1:10 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. x 12 lessons (3 months)

(7) Vocabulary for daily life (N3 level)

This class is for those who have finished studying Japanese equivalent to N4 and want to learn vocabulary necessary for daily life in Japan.

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Tuesdays and Thursdays 1:10 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. x 16 lessons (2 months)

Textbook used: 『Nihongo Goiryoku Up Training』 (Ask)

(8) JLPT N3 (Grammar)

*This class is for those who have completed Japanese language study equivalent to N4 and wish to learn N3 grammar.

Mondays and Wednesdays 1:10 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. x 24 lessons (3 months)

Textbook used: 『TRY ! JLPT N3 Bunpou kara nobasu Nihongo』 (ask)

【Others】

Employment support and seminars

*Participants can participate in individual employment support such as how to look for a job, and seminars on the Japanese employment system and social security, etc., according to their individual needs.

We do not provide job referrals.

【Who can participate】

Those who do not understand Japanese and are unable to obtain necessary information and systems.

Those who are unable to find a place to study Japanese, etc.

Those who have access to wifi.
